

Hon'ble Chief Minister's Press Meet - 13.10.2011

Qn: On the Kudankulam issue, what is the next step the Tamil Nadu Government is going to take?

Hon'ble CM: In the first place, I haven't received the letter from the Prime Minister yet. The earlier letter that the Prime Minister sent that was dated 4th, I saw it only on the TV and in the media and it was a good 3 days before we actually got the letter. Now this recent letter that the Prime Minister is supposed to have written. I have not yet received it. Let me receive the letter.

Qn: There have been some new twists in the Sankarraman case, the Kanchi Sankaracharya is involved. There are allegations of tapes and now they are seeking retrial. They are saying the Government has changed. Will your Government do whatever is possible?

Hon'ble CM: That is now in the Court. So I don't want to discuss it.

Qn: What would you like to tell the protestors in Kudankulam? They stopped workers from going inside the plant and the situation is chaotic..

Hon'ble CM: This is not something that can be resolved by the State Government overnight. It will take time. I do not wish to make any further comments on this now because it is a very emotive issue and a controversial issue.

Qn: The Supreme Court has said that the Centre should have taken into consideration the Prime Minister's letter in the 2G Scam. The Supreme Court has questioned why Centre was quiet ?

Hon'ble CM: The Supreme Court itself is ceased of the matter. It wouldn't be appropriate for me to make comments on this matter now.

Qn: Prasanth Bhushan was attacked yesterday and today again supporters of Anna Hazare have been attacked..

Hon'ble CM: I am not aware of today's developments. About the attack yesterday it is most condemnable, most reprehensible. There is no place for such attacks in a civilized society.
